# EASY DOUBLE SQUARE BLOCK

## GETTING STARTED

Read all instructions first.

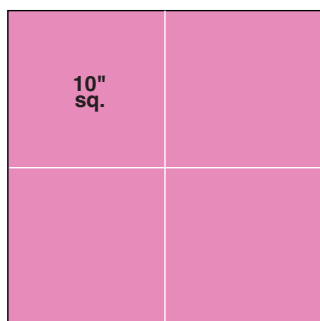
Materials and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Sew with right sides together and using a ¼" seam unless otherwise stated.

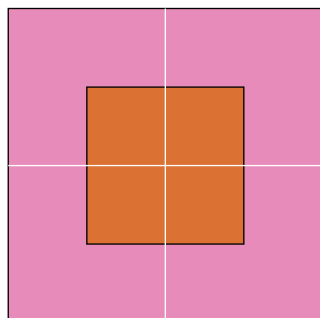
Arrows represent pressing instructions. If no arrows are shown, refer to the written instructions for pressing guidance.

## ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

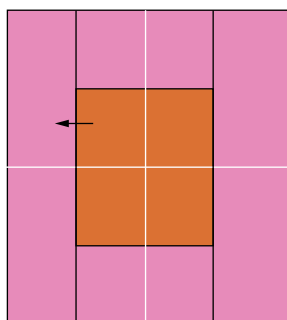
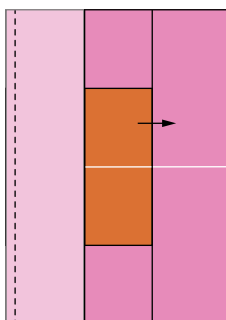
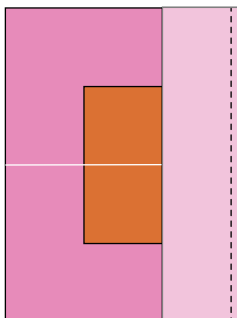
**1.** Fold the 10" square in half lengthwise and widthwise. Press to mark the center points of each side. Repeat for the 5" square.



**2.** Layer the 5" square on top of the 10" square with right sides facing up and all center points aligned. Pin the 5" square in place.



**3.** Fold the right-hand side of the 10" square in to meet the center pressed line. Sew along the folded edge and press. Fold the left-hand side of the 10" square in to meet the center pressed line. Sew and press as before. The sides of the 5" square should now be finished.



**4.** Fold the top of the 10" square in to meet the center pressed line. Sew along the folded edge and press. Fold the bottom of the 10" square in to meet the center pressed line. Sew and press as before to make the Easy Double Square Block. The top and bottom of the 5" square should now be finished. The block should be 9" square including seam allowances.
